Introduction

In addition to the care provided by your doctors in the community or hospital setting, the nurse specialist service offers anyone who has been newly diagnosed with lung cancer or mesothelioma:

- · Information about your diagnosis.
- Emotional support and advice for patients, family and carers.
- · Discussion about individual treatment options.
- Practical advice
- Referral to agencies who can provide support in the community.

The nurse specialist can be contacted Monday to Friday 8:30 am – 4.30pm

A voicemail service is available for non-urgent messages and the nurse specialist will aim to return your call within one working day. If you would like to leave a message, please telephone the above number and follow the instructions.

Please note that this is not an emergency service and does not operate out of office hours. You should contact your GP if you need advice on the same day.

Who else might be involved in my care?

Your hospital consultant will write to your GP with the details of your diagnosis and care plan. Your GP will continue to be the first point of contact whilst you are at home and they will liaise with your hospital consultant and Macmillan lung cancer nurse specialist, as required. You may wish to have additional support of the district nurses who work closely with your GP. The Macmillan lung cancer nurse specialist will discuss this with you and make the referral on your behalf.
