FACE ARMS SPEECH TIME

Has their face fallen on one side? Can they smile?

Can they raise both arms and keep them there?

Is their speech slurred?

To call 999 if you see any single one of these signs

WHEN STROKE STRIKES, Act F.A.S.T.

What do I do if my symptoms return or worsen?

If your symptoms return or become suddenly worse you must seek urgent medical attention by dialling **999**.

When will I be followed up?

Once you have been seen in the stroke ambulatory care unit an outpatient follow-up appointment will be arranged within 6-8 weeks. This will be sent you in the post.

Some patients may require further support to help rehabilitation whilst at home. If this is the case you will have an initial telephone consultation and where appropriate a rehabilitation programme of up to 6 weeks will be implemented.

What if I have any further tests or investigations?

Should you require any further investigations, these will either take place during your appointment or arranged as an outpatient. This will be discussed with you. All outpatient appointments will be sent to you in the post.

How do I get more medications?

If you have been advised to commence any new medications, a prescription will be given to you. You will be advised from the clinic nurse how you can obtain these.

Following your initial appointment should you require anymore medications these can be obtained from your repeat prescription service at your GP surgery.

Driving and travel advice

By law if you have a professional bus or HGV licence you must inform the DVLA if you have:

- been diagnosed with TIA or stroke
- · had more than one TIA in a month
- developed post-stroke seizures or epilepsy

If you have a licence and drive a car, you must inform the DVLA if you have:

- · had more than one TIA in a month
- developed post-stroke seizures or epilepsy
- had a problem with vision and advised to inform DVLA

The current guidelines state you must not drive for one calendar month from the date of your TIA or stroke. However, if your symptoms have fully resolved after one month, you do not need to inform the DVLA and can resume driving.
