What is a Semen Analysis?

This test measures the proportion of mature sperm in your semen sample and is an important assessment for your fertility treatment.

Please read all the information in this leaflet before producing the sample.

Before you produce a sample

- An appointment, to receive the sample, needs to be made with the pathology laboratory at Royal Preston Hospital
- Please call 01772 522104 to book and allow at least 1 week before the intended day of submission
- Appointments are available Monday to Thursday between 9.30am and 3.30pm

How do I take the sample?

- Avoid ejaculation 3-5 days before you produce the sample. This allows sperm to reach full maturity
- You will be provided with a semen container for the sample
- Produce the semen sample, by masturbation, directly into the semen container
- Do not use a condom to collect the sample
- Please write your name, date of birth, date and time the sample was produced on the pot
- Place the semen container in the plastic bag provided
- The sample needs to reach the pathology laboratory at Royal Preston Hospital within **1 hour** of being produced. Please take this into consideration when choosing the time to obtain a sample
