SURGICAL UNIT

- 1. You should rest as much as possible in the first 48 hours following your operation.
- 2. Clothes should be cotton and loose fitting.
- 3. **Starting 24 hours after surgery,** you should have a bath twice daily. Do not add anything to the water. Make sure you sit down in the water.
- 4. Some swelling of the wound area is normal.
- 5. If bleeding occurs, more than you would expect from a cut finger, then get in touch with your GP, or go the Accident & Emergency (A&E) department.
- 6. If you cannot pass urine, sit in a warm bath. This sometimes helps. If you still cannot pass urine, then you must get in touch with your GP or the A&E department.
- 7. The stitches in your wound are dissolvable. They take 2-3 weeks to dissolve.
- 8. You may have been prescribed pain relief. This is to ease discomfort.
- 9. You must avoid swimming in public pools, as this may affect wound healing.

Protection of Healthcare Workers

In accordance with the Department of Health Guidelines for Clinical Care Workers 1998 (Protection against infection with blood-borne viruses), you may be requested to provide a blood sample if a member of staff sustains an injury involving a used needle, sharp instrument and/or contamination with your body fluids.
