Splint Description

Splints are a way of supporting a joint to keep it steady. You have been provided with this splint to help your hand recover or feel less painful. It is provided for your sole use and for the purposes explained by your therapist.

Splint care advice

To clean the support (remove any metal bars first) hand wash with a little detergent and air dry only (do not use heat to dry it). Return to wearing only when dry. Thermoplastic splints can be wiped clean. Do not wash at high temperatures as this will change the shape.

Your splint has been fitted and provided for your use only and must not be used by another person. If your splint becomes ill-fitting e.g., too tight, too loose, too worn or needs the strapping replaced please contact the hand therapy department.
