Difflam provides pain relief for children with sore throats. If used regularly it is very effective.

The Difflam your child has been discharged with is a spray which the nurses will have shown you how to use.

You can use this spray every 1.5 – 3 hours.

Using this spray combined with Paracetamol and Ibuprofen will help encourage your child to drink.







Paracetamol is effective for both pain and/or fever.

No more than 4 doses of the medication should be given in a 24-hour period.

Ibuprofen treats pain and inflammation (swelling) including cold symptoms, teething, toothache, sprains, and strains and reduces a fever.

No more than 3 doses of the medication should be given in a 24-hour period.
