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Management Guidelines: Skull Base CSF Fistulas

Patients with β2-transferrin positive rhinorrhoea, with or without histories of trauma/ intracranial sepsis, undergo a fine-cut coronal bony window CT study through the anterior and middle cranial fossae. If no defect is evident on CT, patients undergo a CT cisternogram.

Patients with a defined skull base defect and persistent leakage undergo surgical repair. The approach depends on the location of the defect:

- > Transcranial Frontal Sinus/ Petrous Temporal Bone
- > Transnasal Endoscopic Ethmoids/ Cribriform Plate/ Sphenoid/ Clivus.
